FIELD TRIPS

All field trips will be announced on the Remind texting system as they get closer. If there is a cost, you will be notified in advance. Some field trips will be offered depending on classes chosen. There is limited space on some trips, so we will choose the members with the highest attendance who haven't had behavior issues. This will be determined by the Site Directors.

DISCIPLINE

We expect all members to behave **respectfully** to each other, staff and property. If there are issues with behavior, we will follow our procedures. First offense is a warning, second is a time-out equal to the child's age, and third will be a note sent home to parents. If the problem continues, the child may be suspended from the program at the discretion of the Director. The BGCN offers a fun, safe environment for all members, and we DO NOT condone behaviors that negatively affect others.

We <u>**DO NOT**</u> allow cell phones or toys from home at the elementary club.

POOL

We will take kids to the Nowata swimming pool daily from 1:00-3:00. Staff will accompany youth and will actively supervise both in and out of the water. Pool days for your child/children will be highlighted on the detailed schedule available at the Summer Program Open House on Thursday, May 29 from 4-6pm. You will be responsible for sending all swimming supplies, including swimsuit, towel, life-jacket/floaties, sunscreen and snack money if desired. Cost to swim is free.
